Blessed is the King Who Comes in the Name of the Lord

Zechariah 9; Luke 19

The Lord Jesus Christ is King!

What kind of king is He, and king of what?

1. Jesus Christ is the king of _____ (Zechariah 9:9).

On that day, Jesus Christ displayed both His mercy and His sovereign power.
Three verses that point to His sovereignty: Luke 19:37; Luke 19:38; Luke 19:40.

But here is the point I want you to see today: This sovereign Christ weeps over hard-hearted, perishing Jerusalem as they _____.

There are at least three ways that Jesus is merciful, which we can draw out of this context.

- a. Jesus' mercy is tenderly moved.
- b. Jesus' mercy was self-denying.
- c. Jesus' mercy intends to help.

2. Jesus Christ is the king of justice (Zechariah 9:9).
3. Jesus Christ is the king of salvation (Zechariah 9:9).

There are two wrong notions that will keep many people out of heaven, and they usually go together.
First, people wrongly believe that God is too loving to send decent, moral people to hell.
The second wrong notion is that most of us are good enough to _____.

4. Jesus Christ is the king of humility (Zechariah 9:9).
5. Jesus Christ is the king of creation.

Jesus Christ is coming again to rule the earth (Zechariah 9:10)!
